With recent history of brutal civil war and genocide, Cambodia is in desperate need of a generation of strong, ethical leaders. In collaboration with our local partner, GSC has established the Community Development and Leadership Training Program in response to this critical shortage.

Through this program, Cambodian youth and young adults are equipped with the tools they need to become peace-minded leaders and agents of social change. GSC volunteers also take a hands-on role in the Community

Development program, actively participating in workshops, trainings and mentorship roles.

By focusing on youth empowerment, peaceful conflict resolution and emotional intelligence (also known as EQ), GSC is working to ensure bright futures for the next generation of Cambodian leaders.




A Tanzanian Year in Summary

Global Service Corps has had a wonderful year in Tanzania! Our programs in Nutrition, Food Security, Sustainable Agriculture and HIV/AIDS Prevention continue to find great success in rural communities in northern Tanzania.

Chronic malnutrition continues to plague Tanzania, causing an alarming 42 percent of children under age five to suffer from the long-lasting effects of stunting. In spite of advances in HIV/AIDS treatment, many rural Tanzanians are not equipped with the knowledge to prevent HIV infection.


